20.11.24:

- Following a PCC Awayday, the MC was asked to focus on outward and missionary activities.
- Ongoing work to include better and wider communication, pew cards to help newcomers become known, and Church Welcoming.
- A holiday club (for 5-11 year olds) is being planned for the May half-term in 2025.

22.1.25:
